“Now I have no hesitation in affirming that a person who for gain engages in the business of manufacturing articles of food and drink intended for consumption by members of the public in the form in which he issues them is under a duty to take care in the manufacture of these articles. That duty, in my opinion, he owes to those whom he intends to consume his products. He manufactures his commodities for human consumption; he intends and contemplates that they shall be consumed. By reason of that very fact he places himself in a relationship with all the potential consumers of his commodities, and that relationship which he assumes and desires for his own ends imposes upon him a duty to take care to avoid injuring them.”



“The rule that you are to love your neighbour becomes in law, you must not injure your neighbour; and the lawyer’s question, Who is my neighbour? receives a restricted reply. You must take reasonable care to avoid acts or omission which you can reasonably foresee would be likely to injure your neighbour. Who, then, in law is my neighbour? The answer seems to me – persons who are so closely and directly affected by my act that I ought reasonably to have them in contemplation as being so affected when I am directing my mind to the acts or omissions which are called in question.”

- The purchaser suffers harm;
- The product was made by the manufacturer or purchased from the seller;
- The product was defective;
- A reasonable person in the position of the manufacturer or seller ought to have foreseen the likelihood of the product being defective and causing harm to that person;
- A reasonable person in the position of the manufacturer or seller would have taken steps to prevent the harm from occurring;
- The seller did not take the steps that a reasonable person in that position would have taken to prevent the harm; and
- The failure by the manufacturer or seller to take these reasonable steps to prevent the harm caused the damage to the injured party.
